## Inmate Accounts

Harrison County Adult Detention Center operates a cashless accounting system. Detainees may receive money from outside sources to be credited to their inmate account. Monies must be in the form of a United States Postal Money Order, Bank Money Order, credit union check or money order. Neither cash nor personal check will be accepted by the Director of Inmate Accounts. Correspondence to the inmate should **not** be included with any funds sent to Inmate Accounts. The senders' full name and address must be on the money order. Money orders must be payable to the inmate, including the inmate's docket number. The maximum value of the money order accepted is \$100.00. Any amount over that will be returned to the sender. A Kiosk machine is located in the lobby of the Detention Center. You can place money on an inmate's account using cash or credit cards. There will be a \$2.00 fee using this method. The inmate must already have an account set up to use the Kiosk machine.
