Deputy Warden made contact with Maria Pereira. Deputy Warden was advised that Pereira had a felony warrant through the Harrison County Sheriff's Department for of Sale of Synthetic Narcotics.

Pereira was placed into custody without incident and transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility where she is being held on a \$30,000.00 Surety Bond set by Justice Court Judge Diane Ladner.

On February 19, 2016 Sheriff Troy Peterson announced the arrest of 36 year old Charles Ivy whom resides at 18620 Reese Drive in Saucier, MS.

On February 18, 2016 Harrison County Deputies responded to 1712 Hwy 49 in Saucier, MS on an Aggravated Assault call. Upon arrival Deputies noticed the victim walking toward them with a stab wound to the neck. Victim stated that he was driving lvy to a residence and for no apparent reason stabbed him in the neck. Victim stated that lvy jumped out of his car and fled the scene before Deputies arrived. Victim was transported to Garden Park Hospital by AMR and later transported to USA Hospital in Mobile, Alabama where he is listed in stable condition.

On February 19, 2016 Harrison County Deputies responded to 1712 Hwy 49 in Saucier, MS after being informed by a witness that Ivy was seen in the trailer park. K-9 Deputy John Putnam made contact with Ivy. K-9 Johnny apprehended Ivy after he resisted arrest. Ivy was transported to Garden Park Hospital for his injuries and released to the custody of Harrison County Sheriff's Department.

Charles Ivy was booked into the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility on a \$100,000.00 dollar bond set by Judge Melvin Ray regarding the Aggravated Assault.
