On Monday, January 10, 2017, Sheriff Troy J. Peterson announced the arrest of 34 year old Russell Aaron Myers who resides at 913 Avenue C, McComb, MS on a felony charge of Failure to Appear on the original charge of Possession of Controlled Substance through St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office.

On January 10, 2017 at approximately 11:49 AM, Deputy Bill Dukes conducted a traffic stop at Daughtery Road and Via Don Ray Drive on a red 2001 Ford for Careless Driving. Deputy Dukes made contact with the driver, Russell A Myers. Deputy Dukes was advised by dispatch that Myers was wanted by St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office for Failure to Appear on an original charge of Possession of Controlled Substance.

Myers was placed into custody without incident and transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility where he is being held awaiting extradition to St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.
