On Tuesday, April 25, 2017, Sheriff Troy Peterson announced the arrests of 18 year old Durente Yarbor who resides at 4016 30<sup>th</sup> St. Gulfport, MS, 19 year old Phineas Williams who resides at 3318 39<sup>th</sup> Ave. Gulfport, MS, 18 year old Albert Morgan III who resides at 104 Danube St. Gulfport, MS, 20 year old Gary Perkins who resides at 3800 Rio Grande St. Gulfport, MS, and 18 year old Jaquan Moffett who resides at 11599 Acorn Drive Gulfport, MS, on two felony charges of burglary of a vehicle.

According to Sheriff Troy Peterson, Harrison County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a complaint of a burglary of a vehicle in the 4000 block of Menge Avenue in Pass Christian, MS. While investigating the complaint, an additional complaint of burglary was received in the area. Harrison County Sheriff's Investigators learned that the Long Beach Police Department had conducted a traffic stop on Klondyke Road in the City of Long Beach with a vehicle occupied by Yarbor, Williams, Morgan, Moffett, and Perkins. Investigators discovered that Long Beach Police had recovered a stolen firearm from the reported vehicle burglary. Sheriff Peterson said that the investigation is ongoing and more charges are possible.

Yarbor, Williams, and Morgan, were booked into the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility and charged with two felony counts of burglary of a vehicle. Yarbor, Williams, and Morgan are being held in lieu of a \$20,000.00 dollar bond set by Justice Court Judge Dianne Ladner. Gary Perkins and Jaquan Moffett were also booked into the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility and charged with two felony counts of burglary of a vehicle. Perkins' is being held without bond for being arrested while out on bond for a previous murder charge through the City of Gulfport. Moffett is also being held without bond for being arrested while out on bond for a previous armed robbery charge also through the City of Gulfport.
