On March 15, 2018, Sheriff Troy Peterson announced the arrests of 21 year old Daniel Ernest Tucker who resides in the 12000 Block of Sandy Hook Lane Gulfport, MS and 25 year old Kayla Wynnie Holloway who resides in the 5000 block of Espy Ave. Long Beach, MS on one felony charge each of Receiving Stolen Property.

According to Sheriff Troy Peterson, a Deputy was driving through the McDonalds parking lot located at 11401 Hwy 49 Gulfport, MS and observed a black Cadillac parked in a handicap parking space with the driver slumped over the wheel. After making contact with the driver, Daniel Tucker, whom originally provided false identifying information and passenger Kayla Holloway, the deputy realized that neither occupant were handicap and began to investigate their suspicious behavior. While running the vehicle's tag, the deputy was informed that the tag returned to a BMW. The deputy then ran the vehicle identification number (VIN) at which time it was determined that the vehicle had been reported stolen from the IP Casino on February 23, 2018.

Sheriff Peterson advised that Tucker and Holloway were transported to the Harrison County Sheriff's Department Criminal Investigation Division where interviews were conducted along with Biloxi Police Investigators. After the interview was completed, it was determined that Tucker and Holloway were not the individuals responsible for the initial theft of the vehicle. However, both had knowledge of the vehicle being stolen.

Daniel Tucker and Kayla Holloway were booked into the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility and charged with one count of each of receiving stolen property. Tucker and Holloway are both being held in lieu of a \$10,000.00 bond set by Justice Court Judge Louis D. Ladner.
