The Harrison County Sheriff's Office is accepting applications for the position of Reserve Officer. This is a volunteer position that does not receive compensation.

Being a Reserve Officer is a position that allows the department to supplement community and Sheriff services while also allowing individuals interested in future law enforcement careers to train and gain experience. It also allows others who have an interest in their community the opportunity to serve it as a law enforcement officer.

Requirements

- Must be at least 21 years old.
- Must have a valid Mississippi Driver's License.
- Must consent to fingerprinting.
- Must consent to background investigation.
- Must successfully complete Reserve Officer Training Course (302 hours over 24 weeks)
- Must have good references documenting good moral character, personal integrity and professional and ethical work related performance.
