On Saturday, March 30, 2019, Sheriff Troy Peterson announced the arrest of 35 year old Remington Gene Steele who resides at 18745 Palmer Creek Drive Saucier, MS, on the felony charges of aggravated assault and possession of a weapon by convicted felon.

According to Sheriff Troy Peterson, Harrison County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 18000 block of Reece Drive for a possible shooting. Deputies made contact with a man who stated he was shot once in the foot and named Remington Gene Steele as the shooter. The victim was transported to a local hospital for medical attention due to the gunshot wound to his foot. Deputies located Steele at his residence and took him into custody without incident. Investigators later learned that Remington Steele had been prevously convicted of a felony crime in the State of Mississippi and was in violation of State Law being in possession of a firearm.

Remington Gene Steele was booked into the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility and charged with one felony count of aggravated assault and one felony count of possession of a weapon by a felon. Remington Gene Steele is being held in lieu of a \$100,000.00 dollar bond set by Justice Court Judge Dianne Ladner.
