On Monday, December 16, 2019, Sheriff Troy Peterson is requesting the assistance of the public to help identify a remaining victim of serial killer Samuel Little

According to Sheriff Troy Peterson in 2018 serial killer Samuel Little began confessing to numerous murders across the United States, including the murders of five women which he picked up in the Gulfport area. Three of his victims have been identified and arrest warrants have been issued. The Harrison County Sheriff's Office has received additional information about a victim from Samuel Little. Little has drawn a sketch of what he remembers this victim to look like. The Harrison County Sheriff's Office will be passing out informational flyers and will be posting on social media the sketch of this victim.
