On Tuesday, August 11, 2020, Harrison County Sheriff Troy Peterson announced the arrest of 43year-old Norman Cook of Biloxi, Mississippi for felony charges of Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute to wit; Cocaine, Crack Cocaine, Marijuana and a felony charge of Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon.

On August 11, 2020, Investigators assigned to the Harrison County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Division, along with Special Agents of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics (MBN), executed a search warrant at 262 Brown Street in Biloxi, Mississippi. The search warrant yielded approximately (3) ounces of cocaine, (14) grams of crack cocaine, approximately (3) pounds of high-grade marijuana and assorted paraphernalia indicative of drug distribution. Additionally, Cook, a convicted felon, unlawfully possessed two semi-auto pistols and an assault rifle. Cook was arrested on scene and is being held at the Harrison County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Center held in lieu of a \$200,000.00 bond set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Albert J. Fountain.
