On Friday, September 26, 2025, Sheriff Matt Haley announced the arrest of 41-year-old Brandon Stabler and 37-year-old Aaron Reeves of D'Iberville, MS on three felony counts of Grand Larceny. Angelica Feliciano, 47 years old, was also arrested and charged with one count of receiving stolen property.

According to Sheriff Matt Haley, Harrison County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 15000 block of East Wortham where catalytic converters and lawn equipment had been stolen. Investigation revealed on the night of September 20, 2025, Brandon Stabler and Aaron Reeves arrived in the area and removed catalytic converters and lawn equipment from multiple vehicles at the location. Investigators obtained video and shared it with the public ultimately identifying the suspects. On September 25, 2025, Investigators traveled to Highway 15 in D'Iberville where the suspects were located along with some of the stolen items. Angelica Feliciano was charged with one count of receiving stolen property in connection to the thefts .

Brandon Stabler, Aaron Reeves, and Angelica Feliciano were booked into the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility. Reeves and Stabler were charged with three counts of Grand Larceny and are being held in lieu of a \$150,000 bond, and Feliciano is being held in lieu of a \$15,000 dollar bond set by Justice Court Judge Diane Ladner.
